Accredited as "Observer NGO" by UN Framework Convention on Climate Change.

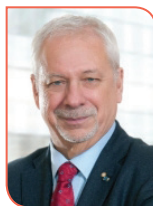


OUR FORESIGHT COMMITTEE

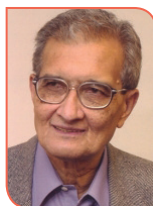
